Will the results be visible in my health record application?

Are there alternative or additional diagnostic tools (e.g., if the test is invasive)?

Will a copy of the results be shared or available to my other HCPs?

What information does this test provide, both in general and then specifically related to the condition or concern?

What is the expected patient experience of the test?

Is there any specific patient preparation required?

When and where should the test be performed?

How soon with the results be available?

How will this test help inform the next steps for the diagnosis or treatment plan?

Are there any risks related to the test?

Are there alternative or additional diagnostic tools (e.g., if the test is invasive)?

Will a copy of the results be shared or available to other HCPs?
